The GPS Watch has also had the advantage of a S.O.F.T. (Satellite Option Finding Technology) Wear pilot project in conjunction with the Halifax Regional Police and the Alzheimer's Society in recent years, proving its benefits.

“My husband has Alzheimer's but is still very active and I was constantly anxious that he may become lost or disorientated,” says Ann West, a caregiver who participated in the S.O.F.T. Wear Project. “With a GPS Watch I have great comfort knowing I have early detection in the case of an emergency, but my husband still has the freedom to plan his days.”

Wrist-worn and user-friendly, it functions like a typical watch, with additional safety features such as an SOS panic button, two way voice communication and programmable safe zones. With many customizable features, caregivers and the individual with dementia can work together to create safe zones and strike a balance between independence and safety.

“When someone with dementia wanders or becomes lost, the first 12-24 hours is a crucial window of opportunity, not being able to locate them within that time can have deadly consequences.” says Tisha White, Program Manager for Northwood Intouch. “Our GPS Watch can save critical time in locating an individual, reducing anxiety for the individual and their families.”
